WINTER REMINDERS 1) WINTER SNOW REMOVAL

Residents are reminded there is to be NO PARKING on city streets from 2 A.M. to 6 A.M. between November 1st and March 31st per City Ordinance.

2) SIDEWALK ORDINANCE

Snow and ice removal from your sidewalk(s) is required within 24-hours of inclement weather.

3) RESIDENTIAL MAIL DELIVERY IN TOWN

Library Giving Tree & Surveys


The Primghar Public Library is accepting donations that will help the whole community this holiday season. Please consider making a donation to be used towards books. For
