WINTER REMINDERS

1) WINTER SNOW REMOVAL

Residents are reminded there is to be **NO PARKING** on city streets from **2 A.M. to 6 A.M.** between **November 1st and March 31st** per City Ordinance. **Parking restrictions are greatly enforced. Parking tickets will be issued, with a \$25.00 fine to be paid at Primghar City Hall.**

2) SIDEWALK ORDINANCE

Snow and ice removal from your sidewalk(s) is required within 24-hours of inclement weather. Residents that are not compliant with this ordinance will receive a one time 24 hour posting. After the first posting, if snow and ice are not removed the city will remove it at a rate of \$100/hour.

3) RESIDENTIAL MAIL DELIVERY IN TOWN

A reminder from the Post Office to those who receive postal mail delivery at or near their home:

It is your responsibility to clear away any snow that should pile up on/around the mailbox and post.



Failure to do so will result in non-delivery.



GARBAGE & RECYCLE CONTAINERS

Please do not place garbage and recycling containers in the street. Instead, please place these containers either at the end of your driveway or in the grass on your front lawn by the curb. Placing containers in these areas makes moving snow, sweeping streets, cleaning leaves, etc. easier for City Employees. The City of Primghar is not liable for damaged containers placed in the street. Thank you

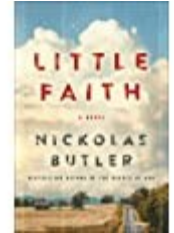
