WINTER REMINDERS

1) WINTER SNOW REMOVAL

Residents are reminded there is to be **NO PARKING** on city streets from **2 A.M. to 6 A.M.** between **November 1st and March 31st** per City Ordinance. **Parking restrictions are greatly enforced.**

Parking tickets will be issued, with a \$25.00 fine to be paid at Primghar City Hall.

2) SIDEWALK ORDINANCE

Snow and ice removal from your sidewalk(s) is required within 24-hours of inclement weather. **Residents that are not compliant with this ordinance will receive a one time 24 hour posting. After the first posting, if snow and ice are not removed the city will remove it at a rate of \$100/hour.**

3) RESIDENTIAL MAIL DELIVERY IN TOWN

A reminder from the Post Office to those who receive postal mail delivery at or near their home: It is your responsibility to clear away any snow that should pile up on/around the mailbox and post.

Failure to do so will result in non-delivery.

Welcome to the 2022 golf season! ***We are excited for another year which will be kicked off with the annual meeting on Friday, March 25th***. Come early for social hour beginning at 5:30 p.m. with the meeting starting at 6:30. A 3-meat dinner buffet will follow at 7:15 p.m. Everyone in attendance will be eligible for door prizes.

Terms are expiring for 2 golf board positions currently held by Ashli Gesink and Bobby Rushton. Ashli and Bobby will both be running for 3-year terms. If you or someone you know is interested in adding their name to the ballot, please contact any one of the current board members.

We have included the 2022 Primghar Golf & Country Club membership form, in effect after 3/1/22, for your convenience. A number of memberships have already been renewed by taking advantage of the Early Bird Special, which expires on 3/1. ALL Memberships paid on or before the annual meeting on March 25th will receive passes for 2 FREE 9-hole rounds of golf. We will again be offering an incentive for members who recruit NEW or previous members who haven't joined in the past 5 years. ***Please do not deduct this amount from your membership total-you will get a \$50.00 bonus check after the new or previous member has paid their membership fees in full. This year, we ask that all membership forms be dropped off with payment at the PGCC clubhouse anytime before the annual meeting, the night of the meeting or after, as long as you have paid before your first round of golf. (A 5% fee will be charged if paying with credit or debit card.)*** If you have any questions, please feel free to contact any board member.

Our membership form includes an optional reciprocity fee for the bargain price of \$25 for a single or \$50 for family. This revenue stays at PGCC. Participating members can golf at Paullina Golf Club, Sanborn Golf & Country Club, Meadowbrook Golf & Country Club in Hartley, Marcus Community Golf Club, Sheldon Golf & Country Club, Sioux Golf and Country Club in Alton, Cherokee Golf & Country Club or Little Sioux Golf & Country Club in Sioux Rapids. Green fees will be waived at these courses, but golf cart rental is required according to each course's policy. These courses can then offer similar options to their members as well-remember that PGCC golf league team members must hold their primary membership with Primghar Golf & Country Club.

Men's league meeting for both Monday and Tuesday leagues will be on Tuesday, April 19th. Ladies' League meeting is the following night on Wednesday, April 20th. These meetings will be held in the clubhouse with social hour starting at 6:00 p.m. and meetings beginning at 7:00. All league participants AND substitutes are required to pay one computerized handicap fee **per league**, which is on the membership form. *(League dues will be charged per league as well for the 2022 season-these dues are collected separately by league treasurers.)* ***Please try to attend these meetings if you are playing league golf.*** The tournament book has been updated with 2022 sign-up sheets and is available in the pro shop. We encourage you to sign up early for these tournaments, and please invite your friends and family to play also!
