

ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Furniture/Mattresses/Box Springs
- ♦ Scrap Metal
- ♦ Household items, including appliances
- Small amounts of wood (6ft or shorter bundled in 40# or less)
- Carpet (cut & rolled into lightweight 4ft bundles)
- Paint cans (DRY paint only, lid removed)
- Motors/Batteries/Tires WITH rims

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Rubber Tires (no rims)
- ♦ Chemicals
- Yard waste or regular garbage
- ♦ Concrete
- Demolition and remodeling debris

**The City of Primghar, Orange City Sanitation, and Samson Development have the right to reject any items placed out for collection. If your items are not picked up, there is a reason. You will be responsible for removing them from the curb and properly disposing of them within three (3) days.
