MUNICIPAL UTILITIES

Utility Rates

New Electric, Water, and Sewer rates are now in effect. Below are the new rates.

Residential Electric Rates:

Customers in City Limits: \$14.50 Base Fee

Rural Customers: \$19.00 Base Fee

Summer Rate (June - September): \$0.101 per kilowatt hour.

Winter Rate (October - May) \$0.094 for the first 1,000 kilowatt hours used Anything over 1,000 kilowatt hours is at a rate of \$0.065.

Commercial Electric Rates:

Single Phase Base Rate: \$26.00

Three Phase Base Rate: \$34.00

Energy Charge

0-1,000: \$0.096

1,001-10,000: \$0.096

Over 10,000: \$0.073

Water Rates:

Residential customers **inside** the city limits: \$18.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000 .

Residential customers **outside** of the city limits: \$21.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000.

Commercial customers **inside** the city limits: \$26.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000.

Commercial customers **outside** of the city limits: \$31.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000.

Sewer Assessment Rates:

Residential customers **inside** the city limits: \$31.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000 .

Residential customers **outside** of the city limits, \$36.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000.

Commercial customers **inside** the city limits: \$41.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000 .

Commercial customers **outside** of the city limits, \$46.50 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000.

Storm Water Assessment:

\$1.65 for all customers.
