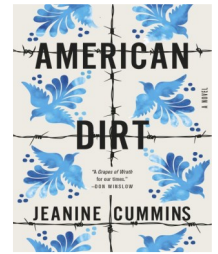

Title VI, Article 3.04

Duty To Trim Trees

The owner or agent of the abutting
 property shall keep the trees on or
 overhanging the street, trimmed so that
 all branches will be at least fifteen (15)
 feet above the surface of the street and
 eight (8) feet above the sidewalks.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12(2c))

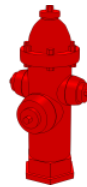
