Please do not place garbage and recycling containers in the street. Instead, please place these containers either at the end of your driveway or in the grass on your front lawn by the curb. Placing containers in these areas makes moving snow, sweeping streets, cleaning leaves, etc. easier for City Employees. The City of Primghar is not liable for damaged containers placed in the street.

UTILITY CONVENIENCES

EASY PAY*: Tired of writing checks or rushing to drop off your payment on time to avoid late fees? We accept any bank and any type of account, checking or savings, and is withdrawn on the 10th of the month.

EVEN PAY*: Budgeting is another offering, allowing set billing amounts each month based on your average rates.

*Authorization forms are available at City Hall. Some restrictions apply.

WINTER REMINDERS

1) WINTER SNOW REMOVAL

Residents are reminded there is to be **NO PARKING*** on city streets from **2 A.M. to 6 A.M.** between **November 1st to April 1st** per City Ordinance.

2) SIDEWALK ORDINANCE

Snow and ice removal from your sidewalk(s) is required within 24-hours of inclement weather.

3) RESIDENTIAL MAIL DELIVERY IN TOWN

A reminder from the Post Office to those who receive postal mail delivery at or near their home: It is your responsibility to clear away any snow that should pile up on/around the mailbox and post. Failure to do so will result in non-delivery.

Playground Updates Coming Soon

The City of Primghar is going to be making some much needed improvements to the city park. These updates will include new rubber mulch ground cover, new swings, two different playground structures complete with slides and climbing structures, and a Gaga Pit.

While this is an exciting project, the total cost for these updates is \$100,382. So far \$47,000 worth of funding has been secured along with future donations to come. This leaves \$53,382 worth of funding that still needs to be secured. Together, with the help of the Primghar Jaycees and Scaritage Park we hope to cut some of the cost in both the funding and help by city and community installation of our new playground.

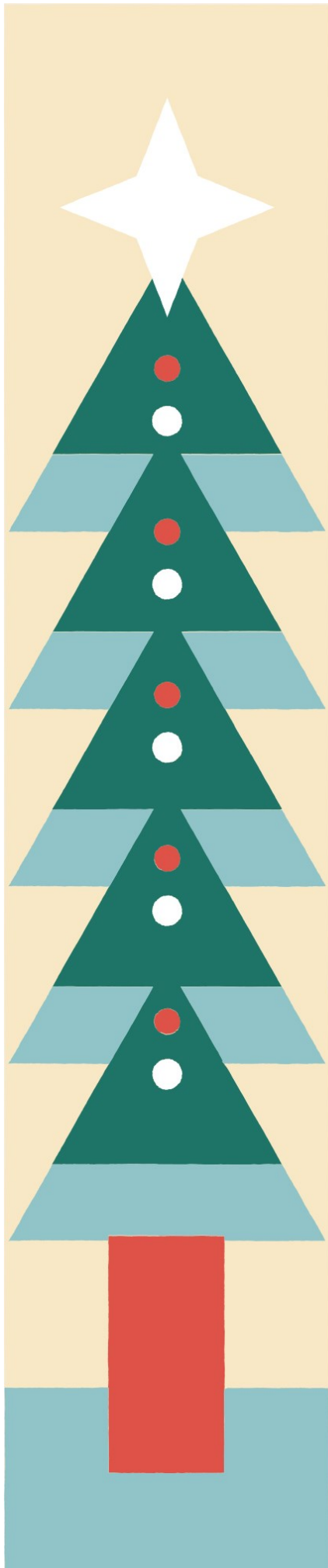
